Over the summer, the CUSD 187 school board voted to change district leadership, including appointing a new superintendent. Some discussions with administration had to be paused for the transition, but I have met with the new superintendent several times. At the time of this newsletter, we are discussing several items that I will report on in my next correspondence. The union has expressed concerns about staffing shortages, specifically people being transferred to positions for

the good of the district when they own different jobs, and new job creations. Our ability to bid to open positions and owning our jobs are contractual rights.

### Mentoring Program

Several years ago, the union lobbied for a teacher induction and mentoring program. Leslie Harder collaborated with our administration and the IFT, and she worked to establish this important program. Thank you to those who have formally agreed to serve as mentors. My role in the process is to help recruit mentors and I appreciate your willingness to support our new people. The district is finalizing placements and preparing to send out letters and guidance to mentors and mentees.

### HR Training Modules - On the Clock Time Agreed Upon

For all staff, the union requested that the superintendent provide on the clock time for the HR training modules. At the time of this newsletter, the district is working to finalize times for this to happen. They had to reschedule PD to allow for this time, so we may not all get time on the same day. It appears that we will get time during an upcoming SIP day.

There will be opportunities for members to get more involved and have a bigger voice this year in the union. I look forward to working together, and I wish you a successful school year.

# **AFT Teach Conference**

CFT 1272's Vice President Erin Reeb and Secretary Christin Oleson traveled to Washington, DC from July 21-23 to attend AFT's TEACH 2023 Conference. They were able to attend workshops focusing on integrating professional issues into the core of the union's work by using a systems approach. This would broaden the union's role to rethink organizational structure, professional learning and most importantly elevating members' voices and advocacy. This approach would include having joint custody between the district, community, and union by developing collaborative partnerships and would engage stakeholders in public responsibility.

They also attended a workshop in which the focus was on literacy reform and the unprecedented wave of reading legislation across the states. This included a comprehensive look at all states and

presenters discussed the challenges that are occurring with the implementation of some of this legislation and how the AFT and local unions can be supportive. Feel free to reach out to Christin Oleson if you are interested in seeing this data.
